32nd Annual SUDBURY 80'S INVITATIONAL TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All games will consist of two (2) twelve (12) minute stop time periods and one (1) fourteen (14) minute stop time period.
2. The ice will be resurfaced every two (2) periods of play.
3. The home team is the second team listed on the schedule (as noted). The home team will wear their dark jerseys when possible.
4. The final (Championship) games will consist of two (2) twelve (12) minute stop time periods and one (1) fourteen minute stop time period.
5. There will be no overtime for round robin games which are tied at the end of regulation time.
6. When a player is assessed his fourth (4) penalty he shall be ejected from the game immediately by the referee.
7. A player who is on the ice at the time of the infraction must serve the ejected player's penalty.
8. A player who receives a match penalty will be suspended from the tournament.
9. Any player fighting during a game will be ejected from the game and be automatically suspended until a ruling has been made by the chairman of the tournament.
10. Semi-final and final games shall be played until a winner is declared. All overtime periods shall be two (2) minutes stop time sudden victory as follows:
 - 1 - 1st overtime - 4 skaters + 1 goalie
 - 2 - 2nd overtime - 3 skaters + 1 goalie
 - 3 - 3rd overtime - 2 skaters + 1 goalie
 - 4 - 4th overtime - 1 skater + 1 goaliePenalties during overtime play - the non-penalized team will add a player.
11. All standing ties in a division shall be broken by:
 - a) If 2 teams are tied, the winner of the game between the 2 shall advance.
 - b) If 2 teams are still tied or 3 or more teams are tied, NOHA Tie Breaking formula will be used.
 - c) If still tied, penalty minutes will be used (the highest in PIM will be eliminated)
 - d) The team that scored the fastest goal at the beginning of any round robin game

NOTE: TEAMS MUST BE READY TO PLAY FIFTEEN (15) MINUTES BEFORE SCHEDULED TIME
